### A. General Health Sciences:

- ❖ Permanent residence in the Lloydminster area
- ❖ Personal reference
- ❖ Reference from a program Instructor
- ❖ Good academic ability
- ❖ Community Leadership and volunteering
- ❖ Show growth potential in his/her chosen profession.
- ❖ **Students must be enrolled in a health program (not pre-qualifying year) to be considered for award.**

- Permanent residence in the Lloydminster region
- Personal reference
- Reference from a teacher of Nursing
- Good academic ability
- Demonstrated Community Leadership and volunteering

Pat Redden was a pillar of the Hillmond and Lloydminster communities and served for many years as a registered nurse at the Lloydminster Hospital. The broad purpose of the *Pat Redden Memorial Scholarship* is to support Nursing students in successfully completing their studies and to assist in meeting future staffing needs of nursing professionals in Lloydminster. The *Pat Redden Memorial Scholarship* is awarded through a Selection committee appointed by the Board of Directors. This committee ensures that the best candidates are recommended for funding. The final approval comes from the Redden Family, based on prior screening and approval of the scholarship committee.
